Banquet Chef

This position is part time 6-20 hours per week. Cooking Tuesday mornings for ministry breakfast, working event-based weekends. The hours for this position are variable and the individual would be on call for funerals and scheduled to oversee some weddings. Some Sunday's throughout the year would be necessary for department breakfasts, and formal dinners.

Position Summary: Banquet Chef manages food prep and execution for events, and kitchen operations. Banquet Chef assists in menu creation, event planning and communicating ingredient and equipment needs.

General Responsibilities:

- 1. Ensure organized and clean prep and storage areas in kitchen, coolers, and freezers, with proper sanitation practices.
- 2. Training in sanitation, food handling, dishwashing, department policies, and procedures.
- 3. Ensure all banquet kitchen equipment is in working order, and submit repairs to Food Service Coordinator
- 4. Must follow kitchen systems and daily prep/task lists for kitchen efficiency.
- 5. Utilization of all inventory for maximum yield and effective cost control.
- 6. Assist with restocking inventory.
- 7. This position must be available to help out for all events at Res life Church. Assist with creating menus for banquets, events and volunteer rotation that are creative and cost-effective. Some training on "cart supply assembly" will be required.

Position Requirements:

- Culinary Degree preferred or Comparable work experience required.
- Minimum 3-5 years of food service experience, with a culinary degree or equivalent work experience.
- Experience in menu creation and extensive knowledge in food preparation and presentation desired but not required.
- Ability to manage in diverse and fast-paced environments and situations.
- Proficiency in food usage, resourcefulness, cost-effectiveness and waste control.

Physical Requirements: This position will be required to stand for long periods of time with repetitive bending. This position may require lifting up to 50lbs.

The above duties, activities, or responsibilities may be supplemented periodically.
