



Groundskeeper/Facilities

This position is full-time with benefits. April through November hours are Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. December through March hours are full-time with on-demand hours.

About the role:

Maintaining cleanliness, appearance, and health of the Grounds (50+ acres) and vehicles. This position may require operating heavy equipment, which requires an age of 21 or older.

What you will do:

Mowing, trimming, edging, irrigation, vehicle maintenance, parking lot repair, snow removal, ice control, landscaping, and exterior painting. Have the ability to be self-motivated and to perform daily responsibilities when unsupervised.

Build and repair miscellaneous props and decorations, assist with metal fabrication, provide support to the Benevolence Ministry, set up for outdoor events, and install exterior advertising and decorations.

What you bring:

A: Qualifications

- This position requires experience with general lawn maintenance.
- Experienced with electrical, plumbing, carpentry, drywall, and countertops is desired, not required
- Pesticide certification is desired but not required.

B: Characteristics

- Have the ability to be self-motivated and to perform daily responsibilities when unsupervised.
- Must exhibit a personal and growing relationship with God and a teachable spirit.
- Must be committed to continual learning and growth. Must agree and align with the mission, vision, and leadership of Res Life Church.
- We request that this role attend one Sunday morning service weekly in person to become or remain familiar with our culture, beliefs, and structure, and more effectively fulfill this role.
- We request this role to actively volunteer for a Res Life ministry outside their work role and schedule to support our goal of winning souls and making disciples.

Physical Requirements:



This position may require lifting up to 75 pounds and working at heights. This position requires performing repetitive tasks such as lifting, bending, and walking.

This position requires a valid driver's license, proof of insurance, reliable transportation, and compliance with RLC driving requirements.

The above duties, activities, or responsibilities may be supplemented periodically as needed.
