



Senior Graphic Designer

This full-time position has 36 to 40 hours of work and benefits. The hours worked can be Monday through Friday or Sunday through Thursday, and require flexibility for events.

About the Role: This position mentors and leads a team of art and graphic designers.

This position will:

- Leads in artistic design concepts with graphic designers, layouts, images, and typefaces.
- This role works with the CA Director to develop and execute communication strategies, including branding and textual content, to achieve the desired message.
- Share a photography schedule for events and weekend services.
- Meet with the CA Project Manager to determine the project's scope.
- Utilize Adobe Creative Software to craft visual elements that effectively convey the intended message.
- Design layouts and select colors, images, and typefaces to use.
- Present design concepts to the CA Director for approval.
- Incorporate changes recommended by the CA Director or CA Project Manager into final designs.
- Review all designs for errors before printing or publishing them.
- As a leader, this role will attend leadership and staff meetings, hold one-on-one meetings, conduct performance reviews, and address disciplinary issues.

What you bring:

A: Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree or at least 3-5 years of experience and education in Communications and Graphic Design
- Certified Designation(s) in related fields are beneficial, but not required.
- Proficiency with Adobe Creative Suite programs (InDesign, Illustrator, Photoshop, etc.).
- Experience in print and digital graphics, along with knowledge of file preparation.
- Knowledge of current design trends and applications.
- Strong writing, editing, and verbal communication skills.
- Basic knowledge of photography is required.
- Advanced knowledge of graphic design principles.
- Experience in Social Media design and trends
- Assists with other creative projects, including hanging banners, poster displays, signage installation, setting up photo backdrops, and occasional communication with external vendors.
- Bonus knowledge of motion design or traditional art illustrations

B: Characteristics

- Have the ability to be self-motivated and to perform daily responsibilities when unsupervised.
- Must exhibit a personal and growing relationship with God and a teachable spirit.
- Must be committed to continual learning and growth. Must agree and align with the mission, vision, and leadership of Res Life Church.
- We expect that this role will attend one Sunday morning service weekly in person to become or remain familiar with our culture, beliefs, and structure, and more effectively fulfill this role.
- We request this role to actively volunteer for a Res Life ministry outside their work role and schedule to support our goal of winning souls and making disciples.

- They will work collaboratively to offer their knowledge and skills as they relate to the project.

Physical Requirements:

Must be able to lift up to 50 lbs. This position may require extended periods of standing and walking, and must be comfortable with heights.
